In follow-up to the Assembly questions: "What is the retention of the jobs reported from small business clients of the SBDC? Are these jobs full time, part time or seasonal?"

We utilize direct client input to provide the number of retained jobs reported; we believe all client outcomes are greater than reported due to the challenges of obtaining a timely response from each and every client assisted. Jobs retained are expressed as a total of full time, part time and seasonal. However, we can report them as full time, part time and seasonal by category to meet the needs of your inquiry. As a voluntary counseling program, clients are not required to continue counseling follow-up, and there for we only track clients active in counseling.

The economic impact breakdown for these jobs for the third quarter are as follows:

3rd Quarter, 2006 Economic Impact Breakdowns -

Number of Jobs created: (This is reported by clients in counseling during the 3rd Quarter ending 6/30/06)

Part Time: 2
