KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 79-39

PROVIDING FOR THE PLACING OF A CERTAIN PROPOSITION RELATING TO THE NORTH PENINSULA RECREATION SERVICE AREA UPON THE BALLOT OF THE NEXT REGULAR ELECTION.

WHEREAS, the voters of Nikiski precinct 1, Nikiski precinct 2 and Tyonek precinct voted to form a service area known as the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area; and

WHEREAS, controversy has arisen regarding the intent of the ordinance establishing the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area and the extent of the recreation powers conferred by the establishing ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly and the Service Area Board of Directors find it desirable to ascertain the sentiments of the residents of the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area regarding the nature and level of services to be provided by the Service Area, the extent of capital improvements and repayment of the debt outstanding on the original swimming pool;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the following proposition shall be placed upon the ballot of those precincts encompassing the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area at the next regular election:
