ORDINANCE 80-24

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE KENAI RIVER SUBDIVISION SERVICE AREA TO PROVIDE ROAD CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE SERVICES, AND PROVIDING FOR AN APPOINTED BOARD.

WHEREAS, the Assembly finds that construction and road maintenance services are needed within the proposed service area and that such services can best be provided by the establishment of a service area of the Borough since such services cannot be provided by an existing service area, by annexation to a city, or by incorporation as a city; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held by the Assembly on March 20, 1980, in Soldotna, to determine the necessity for this service area;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. Title 16 of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of ordinances is amended by enacting this chapter:

CHAPTER 16.32. KENAI RIVER BRIDGE SUBDIVISION SERVICE AREA.

Section 16.32.010. Boundaries. There is hereby established a service area within the Borough designated the "Kenai River Bridge Subdivision", in that portion of the Borough described as follows:

Being located in NW1/4 of Section 20, T5N, R11W, S.M. and more particularly described as the area with the boundaries of Kenai River Bridge Subdivision, (Ord Lane, Patrick Drive, Woodside Lane, Short Lane, Green Forest Drive, Eastway Road, Westway Road).

Section 16.32.020. Board of Directors. (a) There is hereby established a board of directors for the Kenai River Bridge Subdivision Service Area composed of five (5) members who shall be residents of the service area and appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the Assembly.

(b) The board shall meet periodically at regular and special meetings called by the board. All meetings shall be open to the public as provided by law.

Section 16.32.030. Terms and qualifications. (a) A member of the board of directors shall be appointed for a term of three (3) years and shall serve until his successor has been appointed and sworn to assume the duties of the office, except that the first board shall contain at least two staggered terms as designated in the ordinance.

Section 16.32.040. Powers and Duties. The board of directors of the service area, subject to assembly approval, and appropriation of funds, shall supervise the services within the service area and shall advise the Mayor and the Assembly concerning the administration and operation of the service area.

Section 2. In the event that the service area is approved by the voters in the service area, the Assembly shall enact an ordinance providing for the organization and the rules and regulations to govern the service area.

Section 3. This ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment, and upon approval by the voters of the service area at a special election to be held on June 10, 1980.
