ORDINANCE 82-13

AMMENDING SECTION 16.12.010 OF THE BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES TO APPROVE AN EXTENSION OF THE BOUNDARIES OF THE NIKISKI FIRE SERVICE AREA SUBJECT TO RATIFICATION BY THE VOTERS WITHIN THE PROPOSED SERVICE AREA AND CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION ON THE QUESTION.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Nikiski Fire Service Area has adopted a resolution requesting the Assembly to approve an extension of the boundaries of the Nikiski Fire Service Area; and

WHEREAS, this proposed area would be substantially the same area which is the North Kenai Recreation Service Area boundaries; and

WHEREAS, this uniformity of service area boundaries will tend to eliminate overlapping of different service areas; and

WHEREAS, this proposed change in boundaries will permit the service area to reflect the fact that it is presently servicing oil platforms in the Cook Inlet;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That KPB 16.12.010 is amended to read:

"16.12.010 Established-Boundaries. There is established a service area within the B(B) orough designated the "Nikiski Fire Service Area," including that portion of the B(B) orough described as follows:

Commencing at the township line between T5N and T6N R17W S.M., and the mean high waterline on the westerly shore of Cook Inlet; thence westerly along the township line between T5N and T6N to the westerly boundary of the Kenai Peninsula Borough; thence northerly and easterly along the boundary of the Kenai Peninsula Borough through Cook Inlet to the northeast

Kenai Peninsula Borough Ordinance 82-13 Page 1 of 3 Pages corner of T11N R5W in Turnagain Arm; thence southeasterly to the southerly mean high waterline of Turnagain Arm and the easterly boundary of the Kenai National Moose Range within T10N R4W, S.M.; thence southerly along the easterly boundary of the Kenai National Moose Range to the township line between T8N & T9N R4W; thence westerly along the township line between T8N & T9N to the northwest corner of T8N R9W S.M.; thence southerly along the range line between R9W & R10W to the southeast corner of T6N R10W S.M.; thence westerly along the township line between T5N &T6N to the southeast corner of Section 32 T6N R10W; thence northerly along the section line between Sections 32 & 33 to the northeast corner of Section 32; thence westerly along the section line to the northwest corner of Section 31 T6N R10W on the corporate boundary of the City of Kenai; thence northerly and westerly along the corporate boundary of the City of Kenai to the intersection with the mean low waterline of Cook Inlet and the section line between Sections 23 & 26 T6N R12W S.M.; thence westerly along the section line extended three miles into Cook Inlet; thence southwesterly to the southeast corner of T6N R14W in Cook Inlet; thence westerly along the township line between T5N & T6N to the mean high waterline on the westerly shore of Cook Inlet the true point of beginning."

Section 2. That this ordinance is subject to ratification by voters within the proposed service area and a special election is called for May 11, 1982, for the purpose of approving or disapproving the ballot proposition regarding the changed boundaries of the Nikiski Fire Service Area. The proposition to be placed on the ballot shall read:

PROPOSITION:

"Shall the boundaries of the Nikiski Fire Service Area be amended to include the Cook Inlet area in which the oil platforms are located, and the Tyonek Village area, and the area of the Beluga Coal Fields?"

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect on the day after certification by the Borough Clerk that a majority of the
