**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2006-19-37**

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$100,000
FROM THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, COMMUNITY
AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND APPROPRIATING \$133,000
FROM THE BEAR CREEK FIRE SERVICE AREA CAPITAL PROJECT
FUND FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A PUBLIC SAFETY BUILDING**

WHEREAS, through adoption of KPB Resolution 2006-066, the assembly supported responding to the request for proposals to participate in the Multi-Use Facility Grant Program on behalf of the Bear Creek Fire Service Area (“Service Area”) for funding of pre-construction activities for a public safety building to be located in Bear Creek; and

WHEREAS, adoption of KPB Resolution 2006-056 authorized award of a contract for the Professional and Design Services for this project, in an amount not to exceed \$106,929; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development has notified the Borough that grant funds are available in the amount of \$100,000 for pre-construction activities; and

WHEREAS, the grant, and project costs, require matching funds in the amount of \$133,000; and

WHEREAS, the Service Area has \$133,000 available in account 442.00000.00000.27910 (Bear Creek Fire Service Area Capital Projects Fund, fund balance) to meet the match requirement; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of November 14, 2006, the Service Area Board approved expenditure of \$133,000 from its capital projects fund, fund balance account to meet the matching requirements of the grant; and

WHEREAS, the grant amount combined with the matching funds provides a total of \$233,000 for pre-construction activities costs, which includes preparing design development documents, completing the facilities business plan, refining project costs, and development of a plan to finance the construction; and

WHEREAS, a public safety building in Bear Creek will provide a more efficient, higher level of services and provide protection for valuable response equipment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to accept a grant from the Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development in the amount of \$100,000 on behalf of the Service Area for pre-construction costs for a public safety building, and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept and expend the grant and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That grant funds in the amount of \$100,000 are appropriated to account 442.51210.07423.49999 (Public Safety Building project account).


SECTION 3. That Service Area funds in the amount of \$133,000 are appropriated from account No. 442.00000.00000.27910, the Bear Creek Fire Service Area Capital Project Fund, fund balance, to account 442.51210.07423.49999 (Public Safety Building project account).

SECTION 4. That pursuant to Resolution 2006-036, a fee of 3.04 percent will be charged against the project to cover general administrative costs.

SECTION 5. That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriation established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.


SECTION 6. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.

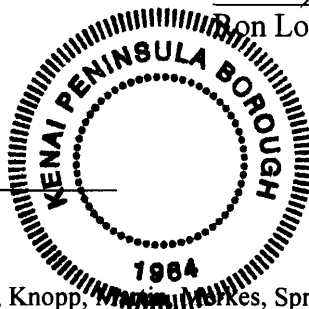
