**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2006-19-38**

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$421,000
FROM THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, COMMUNITY
AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND APPROPRIATING AND
REDIRECTING ANCHOR POINT FIRE AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL
SERVICE AREA CAPITAL PROJECT FUNDS OF \$364,522 FOR
CONSTRUCTION OF A FIRE STATION IN NIKOLAEVSK**

WHEREAS, through adoption of KPB Resolution 2006-059, the Mayor was authorized to participate in the Community Development Block Grant Program in cooperation with the Anchor Point Fire and Emergency Medical Service Area (“Service Area”) to request funding for a fire sub-station in Nikolaevsk; and

WHEREAS, the project is divided into two phases, one for pre-construction activities such as site work and schematic designs, and phase two for construction which begins with construction documents and ends with substantial completion of the station; and

WHEREAS, Phase 1 of this project, which should be completed shortly, was funded through the Service Area’s approved FY06 capital budget; and

WHEREAS, Phase 2 of this project is expected to cost approximately \$785,522; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development has notified the Borough that grant funds are available in an amount up to \$421,000 for project construction; and

WHEREAS, the grant program requires matching funds in the amount of \$364,522; and

WHEREAS, the Service Area has \$364,522 available by redirecting previously appropriated funds for the construction of a new station and purchase of firefighting equipment as well as in the fund balance of the Service Area’s Capital Replacement Fund; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of July 17, 2006, the Service Area Board approved expenditure of up to \$440,000 from the capital projects account to meet the matching requirements of the CDBG grant; and

WHEREAS, the grant amount combined with the matching funds provide a total of \$785,522 for Phase 2 of this project; and

WHEREAS, a fire station in the Community of Nikolaevsk will provide a higher level of fire and emergency medical services, provide protection for valuable firefighting and emergency medical equipment, and possibly improve the ISO ratings and decrease the cost of insurance premium to the residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to accept a grant from the Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development in the amount of \$421,000 for the Service Area to construct a fire station in Nikolaevsk, and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept and expend the grant and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That grant funds in the amount of \$421,000 are appropriated to account 444.51410.07442.49999 (Nikolaevsk Fire Station Project account) for the construction of a fire station in Nikolaevsk.

SECTION 3. That Service Area funds in the amount of \$80,018 are appropriated from the Anchor Point Fire and Medical Emergency Service Area Capital Project Fund, fund balance, account 444.00000.00000.27910, to account 444.51410.07442.49999 (Nikolaevsk fire station project account).

SECTION 4. That Service Area funds in the amount of \$284,504 are redirected to account 444.51410.07442.49999 (Nikolaevsk fire station project account) from previously appropriated amounts for the construction of a new station or purchase of firefighting equipment as follows:

\$84,428 redirected from 444.51410.03BTA.49999 (Emergency Response Equipment Facility Project account)

\$23,076 redirected from 444.51410.3INT1.49999 (SBB Interest Allocation for Equipment/Firefighting Construction Project account)


\$177,000 redirected from 444.51410.06441.49999 (New Station Development Project account)

SECTION 5. That pursuant to Resolution 2006-036, a fee of 3.04 percent will be charged against the project to cover general administrative costs.

SECTION 6. That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriation established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.


SECTION 7. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.

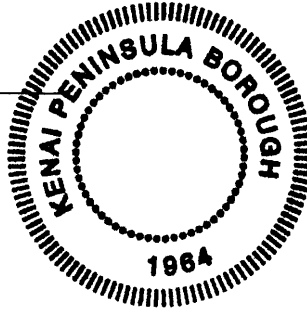
