KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2011-11

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING KPB 2.04.060 TO INCREASE THE **MAYOR'S SALARY TO \$99,000**

- WHEREAS, the borough mayor's salary was set at \$79,000 in 1990 and has since been raised once to \$80,000; and
- WHEREAS, had the mayor's salary been adjusted for inflation in the ensuing 21 years it would now be over \$135,000; and
- WHEREAS, increasing that salary by one percent per year, which is less than inflation, would set it at \$98,333 for FY 2012; and
- WHEREAS, in this same time period most borough employees have received cost of living allowances, but not the office of the mayor; and
- WHEREAS, by borough code the mayor's salary may only be adjusted through the budgeting process preceding the mayoral election; and
- WHEREAS, increasing the mayor's salary may encourage additional experienced managers to consider public service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That KPB 2.04.060 is hereby amended as follows:

2.04.060. Salary.

- A. Compensation for the borough mayor shall be \$[79,000] 99,000 per year.
- В. The mayor's salary may be adjusted at the end of each term of office through the budgeting process preceding the mayoral election.
- SECTION 2. That this ordinance takes effect upon commencement of the term of office of the borough mayor following certification of the 2011 regular borough election.
