## Dear President Knopp:

The purpose of this correspondence is to inform you that on June 3, 2011, the City of Kenai held a public meeting during which property owners could and ask questions regarding the above-referenced ordinance.

The City notified the 92 owners of the 191 properties which may be affected by the ordinance. Five property owners attended the meeting in addition to officials from the City of Kenai. The City of Kenai is the owner of 25 of these properties.

The meeting was also attended by Mr. John Czarnezki who provided information about the ordinance and answered questions. Mr. Czarnezki was knowledgeable and was able to answer the questions which were asked.

None of the property owners expressed opposition to the ordinance.

Based on the above, please disregard my previous request asking that the Assembly postpone action on this legislation.
