**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2011-19-09**

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$4,500,000 FROM THE
STATE OF ALASKA TO THE BOROUGH ROAD SERVICE AREA FOR CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS**

WHEREAS, the Road Service Area (RSA) has compiled a list of road capital improvement projects that qualify for state funding; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 46, which appropriated funding to the borough for road improvements, was passed by the State Legislature and signed by the Governor on June 29, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the borough received notice from the State of Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development that a legislative grant in the amount of \$4,500,000 has been awarded to the borough for road improvements; and

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting on August 23, 2011, the RSA Board of Directors approved RSA Resolution 2011-12 and recommended acceptance of the \$4,500,000 from the State of Alaska for Kenai Peninsula Borough road improvement projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to accept on behalf of the Road Service Area a grant from the Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development in the amount of \$4,500,000 for road improvements, and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept the grant and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That grant funds in the amount of \$4,500,000 are hereby appropriated to 434.33950.12383.49999 a project account.

SECTION 3. That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriations established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.


SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.

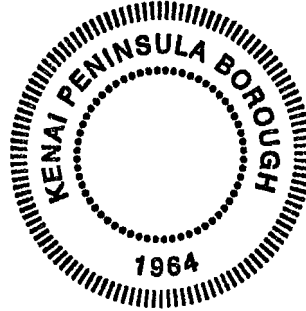
