## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2011-19-13

## AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$350,000 FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA AND APPROPRIATING \$450,000 TO THE KACHEMAK EMERGENCY SERVICE AREA CAPITAL BUDGET FOR THE DIAMOND RIDGE FIRE STATION AND EQUIPMENT BUILDING PROJECT

- WHEREAS, the Kachemak Emergency Service Area (KESA) requested funding to build the Diamond Ridge fire station and equipment building in the borough's 2011 legislative priorities; and
- WHEREAS, Senate Bill 46, which appropriated funding to the borough for the project, was passed by the State Legislature and signed by the Governor on June 29, 2011; and
- WHEREAS, notice has been received from the State of Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development that a legislative grant in the amount of \$350,000 has been awarded to the borough on behalf of KESA for the project; and
- WHEREAS, additional funds in the amount of \$100,000 are available in the KESA capital project fund balance to supplement the grant funds; and
- WHEREAS, at its regular meeting on June 9, 2011, the KESA Board of Directors passed a motion recommending grant acceptance;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to accept, on behalf of the Kachemak Emergency Service Area, a grant from the State of Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development in the amount of \$350,000 for the Diamond Ridge fire station and equipment building project, and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept and expend the grant and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.
- **SECTION 2.** That funds in the amount of \$450,000, consisting of grant funds in the amount of \$350,000 and KESA funds in the amount of \$100,000, are appropriated to 446.51810.12379.49999, a project account.

SECTION 3. That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriations established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
