**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH  
ORDINANCE 2011-19-19**

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$150,000 TO THE NIKISKI FIRE SERVICE AREA CAPITAL PROJECT FUND TO SUPPLEMENT SERVICE AREA FUNDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO TANKER/PUMPER FIRE TRUCKS**

**WHEREAS**, the Nikiski Fire Service Area (NFSA) requested funding to purchase a tanker/pumper fire truck in the borough's 2011 legislative priorities; and

**WHEREAS**, Senate Bill 46, which appropriated funding to the borough for the apparatus, was passed by the State Legislature and signed by the Governor on June 29, 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, notice has been received from the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development that a legislative grant has been awarded in the amount of \$150,000 to the borough on behalf of the NFSA for the project; and

**WHEREAS**, funds of \$900,000 were appropriated in the FY2012 NFSA capital budget for the purchase of the two tanker/pumper fire trucks; and

**WHEREAS**, at its regular meeting on August 10, 2011, the NFSA Board of Directors passed a motion recommending grant acceptance;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

**SECTION 1.** That the mayor is authorized to accept, on behalf of the Nikiski Fire Service Area, a grant from the Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development in the amount of \$150,000 for the purchase of a tanker/pumper fire truck, and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept and expend the grant and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.

**SECTION 2.** That grant funds in the amount of \$150,000 are accepted and appropriated to account number 441.51110.12411.48514, FireFighting/Rescue Equipment.


**SECTION 3.** That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriations established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.

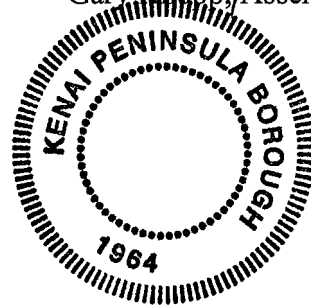
**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
