**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2011-19-52**

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$15,847 FROM THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AND VETERAN AFFAIRS, DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT TO SUPPORT LOCAL TRAINING ACTIVITIES

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska will conduct the 2012 Alaska Shield Exercise to test local, state, tribal, private, non-governmental, and federal response plans and emergency center operations to a prolonged extreme cold weather event; and

WHEREAS, the exercise will assess interoperable communication, information sharing and dissemination, emergency public information, sheltering of displaced persons, continuity of operations plans and emergency operations center management; and

WHEREAS, the borough applied for a State Homeland Security Program grant to partially fund participation in the exercise; and

WHEREAS, award notification has been received from the Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management that funds in the amount of \$15,847 may be used for wages, supplies and transportation; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the borough to accept these funds for the purpose of participating in the 2012 Alaska Shield exercise;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to accept \$15,847 from the State of Alaska Department of Military and Veteran Affairs, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management.

SECTION 2. That grant funds in the amount of \$15,847 are appropriated to account 271.11250.12SLD.49999.

SECTION 3. That the mayor is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept and expend the grant, and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.


SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.

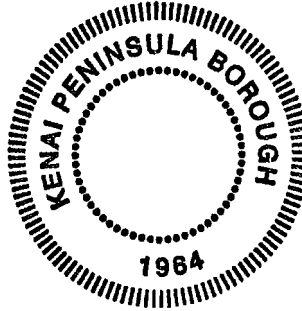
