SUBJECT: Ordinance 2011-19- 60, Accepting and appropriating \$22,243 from the Alaska Department of Military and Veteran Affairs, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management to support the activities of the Kenai Peninsula Citizen Corps.

The Kenai Peninsula Borough Office of Emergency Management is participating in a federal program to encourage the development of disaster preparedness within local communities. This program develops and supports the Kenai Peninsula Citizen Corps which was previously recognized by Resolution 2006-053.

The Kenai Peninsula Citizen Corps is a series of volunteer-based programs that provide communities with training, resources to help identify disaster risks and develop solutions, opportunities to connect local leaders, and volunteers and first responders to help build stronger, safer and better prepared communities. This program now has 187 trained volunteers within the peninsula that are ready and prepared to respond and assist their neighbors in a disaster.

The Alaska Department of Military and Veteran Affairs, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management has provided funding in the amount of \$22,243 to support the activities of the Kenai Peninsula Citizen Corps.

Eric Mohrmann, Emergency Management Director shall be the project manager for the grant funds. The performance period ends December 31, 2013.
