- **RE:** Ordinance 2011-29, authorizing the assessor to accept late-filed senior citizen exemption applications for 2011

This ordinance was introduced on August 2, 2011, to request the assembly find good cause for waiving the deadline of two late-filed senior citizen exemption applications. After the ordinance was drafted it was brought to my attention that Jimmie L. Boyd had missed the 2011 application deadline for a senior citizen exemption on his property, because he did not think he could file his application until he had a copy of his birth certificate. Therefore, he did not file his application until March 16, 2011.
