**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2011-19-77**

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$106,350 FROM
THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AND VETERAN AFFAIRS,
DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT
TO PURCHASE DISASTER MANAGEMENT EQUIPMENT, EMERGENCY
SHELTERING SUPPLIES AND TO CONDUCT CERT TRAINING**

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, Division of Homeland Security & Emergency Management (DHS&EM) provides funds to enhance the capability of local governments to prevent, deter, respond to and recover from all-hazard incidents and to enhance regional preparedness efforts; and

WHEREAS, the DHS&EM State Homeland Security Program is a federal grant passed through the Federal Emergency Management Agency that provides funding for planning, equipment, training and exercises; and

WHEREAS, the borough applied for funding to purchase two trailers, equipment and supplies for disaster management, emergency sheltering supplies and to conduct Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) training; and

WHEREAS, award notification in the amount of \$106,350 has been received from DHS&EM to be used for the equipment, supplies and training; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the borough to accept the grant funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to accept \$106,350 from the State of Alaska Department of Military and Veteran Affairs, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management and to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept and to expend the grant funds and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That grant funds in the amount of \$106,350 are appropriated to account 271.11250.34076.49999.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.

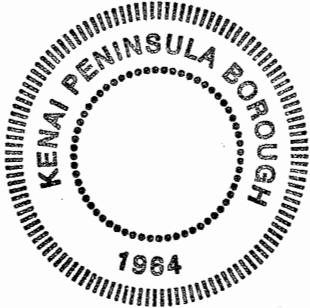
