**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2012-18**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ASSESSOR TO ACCEPT THE LATE-FILED
DISABLED VETERAN EXEMPTION APPLICATION OF JAMES M. BOYER FOR
2012, FILED AFTER MARCH 31**

WHEREAS, KPB 5.12.105(E) provides that an application for a disabled veteran exemption must be filed by February 15 of the year for which the exemption is sought; and

WHEREAS, consistent with AS 29.45.030(f) and KPB 5.12.105(E) late-filed applications may be accepted by the assembly until March 31 of the year for which the exemption is sought, for good cause shown; and

WHEREAS, KPB 5.12.105(E)(5) allows for the assembly to waive the claimant's failure to file the application by March 31 based on the claimant's inability to comply caused by a serious condition or extraordinary event beyond the taxpayers control;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. Upon reviewing James Boyer's application and affidavit submitted with this ordinance, for good cause shown the assembly waives the March 31 deadline for filing the disabled veteran exemption application based on a finding that Mr. Boyer's inability to comply with the March 31 deadline was caused by a serious condition or extraordinary event beyond his control.

SECTION 2. That the assessor shall process the application in accordance with standard assessing department procedures for processing such applications.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
