**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH  
ORDINANCE 2012-19-29**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$769,228 FROM THE CENTRAL PENINSULA HOSPITAL PLANT REPLACEMENT AND EXPANSION FUND FOR REMODELING OF THE OBSTETRICS AREA AND RELOCATION OF INFUSION THERAPY, WOUND CARE, MASSAGE THERAPY AND SPEECH THERAPY**

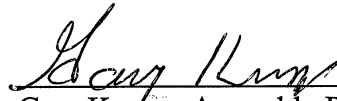
- WHEREAS,** to improve patient care, Central Peninsula Hospital (CPH) plans to relocate Infusion Therapy next to the new Radiation Oncology Center, allowing patients better access when accessing both services; and
- WHEREAS,** relocating the existing Wound Care, Massage Therapy and Speech Therapy to the current Infusion Therapy location will allow for improved security and renovation in the obstetrics (OB) area; and
- WHEREAS,** renovation of the OB will improve the Nursery space, Labor Tub space, and overflow rooms in the OB area through window replacement, medical gas replacement, labor tub relocation, and nursery remodel; and
- WHEREAS,** the Central Peninsula General Hospital, Inc. board at its August 30, 2012, meeting approved the use of the Plant replacement and expansion funds for this project; and
- WHEREAS,** the Central Kenai Peninsula Hospital Service Area board did not consider this ordinance due to the lack of a quorum at its meeting of September 10, 2012, and waiver of the requirement for service area board comment is appropriate because of the need to proceed expeditiously with the project;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

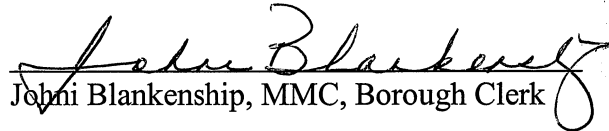
- SECTION 1.** That \$769,228 is appropriated from the Central Peninsula Hospital Plant Replacement and Expansion Fund to account 490.81110.13OBR.49999 for this above-described project.
- SECTION 2.** The Central Kenai Peninsula Hospital Service Area board's consideration of this ordinance as required in paragraph 12(b)(iii) of the Lease and Operating Agreement is hereby waived due to the lack of a quorum for the service area board meeting scheduled for September 10, 2012, and the need to proceed expeditiously with this project.

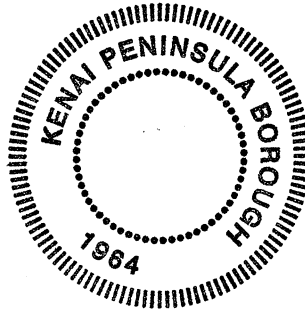
SECTION 3. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
