**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH  
ORDINANCE 2012-19-36**

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING EMERGENCY RESPONSE EQUIPMENT FROM THE  
SOUTHERN REGION EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES COUNCIL, INC., AND  
APPROPRIATING MATCHING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$9,976.32 ON BEHALF  
OF KACHEMAK EMERGENCY SERVICE AREA**

- WHEREAS,** Kachemak Emergency Service Area (KESA) submitted an application to the Southern Region Emergency Medical Services Council, Inc. (Southern Region) for an equipment grant; and
- WHEREAS,** Southern Region notified KESA that the application for emergency response equipment has been approved; and
- WHEREAS,** the total equipment purchase is \$66,508.94, which includes two defibrillators with monitors and support equipment and one power gurney; and
- WHEREAS,** Southern Region has purchased the equipment using federal and state funding sources to pay for 85 percent of the total cost; and
- WHEREAS,** KESA is required to provide the 15 percent local matching funds; and
- WHEREAS,** KESA requests a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$9,976.32 from its Capital Fund, fund balance to meet the required match; and
- WHEREAS,** at its regularly scheduled meeting held November 8, 2012, the KESA Board recommended enactment by unanimous consent;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI  
PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

- SECTION 1.** That the Mayor is authorized to accept the emergency response equipment valued at \$66,508.94 from the Southern Region Emergency Medical Services Council, Inc., on behalf of the Kachemak Emergency Service Area.
- SECTION 2.** That matching funds in the amount of \$9,976.32 are appropriated from the KESA Capital Projects Fund, fund balance to account 446.51810.13BLU.48311 for the match funds needed for this purchase of this equipment.

**SECTION 3.** That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriations established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.

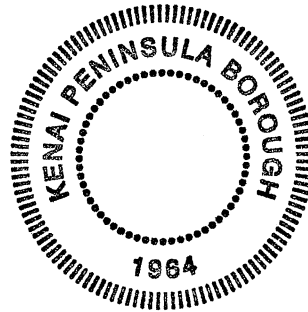
**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.
