## STATE OF ALASKA FEDERAL DISASTER DECLARATION FACT SHEET

NOVEMBER 27, 2012

On November 27, 2012, President Obama issued a major disaster declaration for the State of Alaska triggering the release of Federal funds to help communities recover from Severe Storm, Straight-line winds, Flooding, and Landslides occurred September 15-30, 2012. Details of the disaster declaration and assistance programs are as follows:

Declaration Number: FEMA-4094-DR

Incident: Severe Storm, Straight-line winds, Flooding, and Landslides

Incident Period: September 15-30, 2012

Federal Coordinating Officer: Kenneth K. Suiso  
National FCO Program

Public Assistance (PA): (Assistance for emergency work and the repair or replacement of disaster-damaged facilities):

Designated Borough: Alaska Gateway REAA, Chugach REAA, Denali Borough, Kenai Peninsula Borough, and the Matanuska Susitna Borough.

Hazard Mitigation (HM): (Assistance for actions taken to prevent or reduce long-term risk to life and property from natural hazards):

Designated Boroughs and Areas: All boroughs and Regional Educational Attendance Areas in the State of Alaska are eligible to apply for assistance under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.

OTHER: Additional designations may be made at a later date if requested by the state and warranted by the results of further damage assessments.
