NOW, THEREFORE, THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

1. Declares Soldotna to have received the highest number of votes and therefore to be the selection for the borough seat: Irvin L. Metcalf to have received 372 votes and therefore have been elected to the three year assembly term: Harvey Ainsworth to have received 484 votes and therefore to have been elected to the one year remaining of an unexpired term; Wade Jackinsky to have received 2,027 votes

and therefore to have been re-elected to the five year school board term.

- 2. Take note that the returns from Tyonek precinct have been delayed in the mail and have not arrived and that the certificate of election results includes the vote from this precinct as transmitted by radio by the precinct board chairman and declares that this resolution is subject to confirmation by the assembly at the next meeting after receipt of certification of the results of Tyonek precinct by the election board of the precinct in which the borough office is located.
