1. Irwin L. Metcalf and Charles W. Rainwater received the highest number of votes, these being 462 and 424 respectively, and therefore have been elected


to the three year assembly terms; that Mrs. Barbara Banta received 291 votes, and therefore has been elected to the one year assembly term.

2. Mrs. Ruth Kilcher received 781 votes and therefore has been elected to the three year school board term; that Harvey A. Ainsworth received 547 votes and therefore has been elected to the one year school board term.
3. Total number of persons voting in the Kenai Peninsula Borough election of October 1, 1968 was 1,981.
