A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION TO PLACE BEFORE THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE NORTH KENAI FIRE SERVICE AREA THE PROPOSITION OF WHETHER BONDS FOR FIRE PROTECTION CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS SHOULD BE ISSUED.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

1. A special election is hereby called to be held October 6, 1970 for the purpose of placing before the qualified voters of the North Kenai Fire Service Area the following proposition:

PROPOSITION:


Shall the Kenai Peninsula Borough incur indebtedness in a sum not exceeding \$150,000 for fire protection capital improvements in the North Kenai Fire Service Area including but not limited to site acquisition, purchase, construction, reconstruction of and the purchase of capital equipment for a fire station or fire stations and issue its bonds or other evidence of indebtedness or both at such times and for such amounts as the assembly may determine with payment thereof to be derived solely from taxes levied within or other revenues attributable to the North Kenai Fire Service Area?


