RESOLUTION 70-29 R

CERTIFICATION OF SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE NORTH KENAI FIRE SERVICE AREA

WHEREAS, the assembly has received from the canvassing board of the Kenai Peninsula Borough "Certificate of Results" of the borough special election held on October 6, 1970 in the North Kenai Fire Service Area which comprises Nikiski precincts 1 and 2, and

WHEREAS, the "Certificate of Results" records the following:

PROPOSITION: Shall the Kenai Peninsula Borough incur indebtedness in a sum not exceeding \$150,000 for fire protection capital improvements in the North Kenai Fire Service Area including but not limited to site acquisition, purchase, construction, reconstruction of and the purchase of capital equipment for a fire station or fire stations and issue its bonds or other evidence of indebtedness or both at such times and for such amounts as the assembly may determine with payment thereof to be derived solely from taxes levied within or other revenues attributable to the North Kenai Fire Service Area?
