- 1. That James V. Arness and Stan Long received 1179 and 1140 votes respectively and are elected to three year terms on the borough assembly having each received in excess of 40% of the votes cast for those seats.
- 2. That no candidate for two school board seats received 40% of the votes cast for those seats; therefore the four candidates receiving the highest number of votes, Carl S. Glick, Linda R. O'Brien. Neil Phelps-Munson and Virginia "Ginny" Savoie will be candidates in a runoff election scheduled for October 25. 1977.
