NOW THEREFORE, THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
DECLARES:

1. That for the office of Borough Mayor C. Keith Campbell and Stanley F. Thompson received 1,405 and 3,335 votes respectively, but neither the necessary 50 percent of the total votes cast for Mayor and will therefore be candidates in a Runoff Election to be held October 28, 1980.

2. That Jane Hammond received 3,040 votes for School Board Member and is elected to a three year term. Joe Arness who received 2,043 votes and Collette Yamamoto who received 1,966 votes will be candidates in the Runoff Election since neither received 40 percent of the votes cast for the seat.

3. That candidates for Borough Assembly District I received over 40 percent and Donald McCloud was elected to Seat A and Darrell Schaefermeyer to Seat B for terms to be decided when all seats are filled.

4. That in District II Tommy Corr received 800 votes and John Lounsbury received 625 votes but neither received the necessary 40 percent and will be candidates in the Runoff Election for Seat A.

5. That in District II John Davis received 1,436 votes thereby being elected to Seat B.

6. That in District II Paul Fischer received 1,447 votes and thereby was elected to Seat C.

7. That in District II Charles Crapuchettes received 1,008 votes, thereby being elected to Seat D.

8. That in District II Merrill Sikorski received 1,221 votes, thereby being elected to Seat E.

9. That in District III Karen McGahan received 1,384 votes, thereby being elected to Seat A.

10. That in District III John Douglas and Tom Harvey received 618 and 598 votes respectively and neither the necessary 40 percent, and will be candidates in the Runoff Election for Seat B.

11. That in District III Jesse Wade received 1,104 votes and is thereby elected to Seat C.
12. That in District III Carl Hille and Onis King received 464 and 492 votes respectively and neither the necessary 40 percent of the votes cast for that seat, and will be candidates in the Runoff Election for Seat D.
13. That in District III Stewart Brandon and Harry Gaines received 696 and 400 respectively and neither the 40 percent necessary and will be candidates in the Runoff election for Seat E.
14. That in District IV Jerry Anderson received 953 votes and is thereby elected to Seat A.
15. That in District IV Carl Glanville received 804 votes and is thereby elected to Seat B.
16. That in District IV Marilyn Dimmick received 807 votes and is thereby elected to Seat C.
17. That in District IV Bobby E. "Gene" McBride received 1,130 and is thereby elected to Seat D.
18. That within the Nikiski Fire Service Area Tom Roberson received 721 votes and is thereby elected to Seat A, a three year term on the Board of Directors.
19. That within the Nikiski Fire Service Area Preston Williams received 689 votes and is thereby elected to Seat B, a three year term on the Board of Directors.
20. That within the Nikiski Fire Service Area Chester Davis received 653 votes and is thereby elected to Seat C, a three year term on the Board of Directors.
21. That within the Nikiski Fire Service Area no candidate filed for the Seat E vacancy and the Board will appoint a member to serve until the next regular election.
22. That in the Nikiski Fire Service Area Kurt Kristensen received 661 votes and is thereby elected to Seat F, a one year term on the Board of Directors.
23. That in the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area Warren Enzler received 496 votes and is thereby elected to Seat A, a two year term on the Board of Directors.

24. That in the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area Carol Unruh received 522 votes and is thereby elected to Seat B, a three year term on the Board of Directors.

25. That in the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area Steven Epperheimer received 441 votes and is elected to Seat D, a two year term on the Board of Directors.

26. That within the Bear Creek Fire Service Area Edward Zimmerman received 113 votes and is thereby elected to Seat A, a three year term on the Board of Directors.

27. That within the Bear Creek Fire Service Area Martin Patterson received 117 votes and is thereby elected to Seat B, a three year term on the Board of Directors.

28. That within the Bear Creek Fire Service Area Lori Draper received 112 votes and is elected to Seat D, a two year term on the Board of Directors.

29. That within the Bear Creek Fire Service Area Robert Ashley received 110 votes and is thereby elected to Seat E, a three year term on the Board of Directors.

30. That within the Ridgeway Fire Service Area (proposed) Proposition 4 was approved by a vote of 325 "Yes" to 183 "No" thereby approving formation of the Service Area.

31. That within the Ridgeway Fire Service Area George A Denison received 355 votes and is thereby elected to Seat A, a three year term on the Board of Directors.

32. That within the Ridgeway Fire Service Area John H. Lounsbury received 339 votes and is thereby elected to Seat B, a three year term on the Board of Directors.

33. That within the Ridgeway Fire Service Area Theodore "Al" Johnson received 331 votes and is thereby elected to Seat C, a two year term on the Board of Directors.

34. That within the Ridgeway Fire Service Area Thomas M. Newby received 187 votes and is thereby elected to Seat D, a two year term on the Board of Directors.

35. That within the Ridgeway Fire Service Area James S. Brindley received 199 votes and is thereby elected to Seat E, a one year term on the Board of Directors.

36. That within the South Peninsula Hospital Service Area Howard Myhill received 1,363 votes and is thereby elected to Seat D, a one year term on the Board of Directors.

37. That within the South Peninsula Hospital Service Area no candidates filed for the Seat G vacancy until after the deadline for filing. Declared Write-in candidates Diana McDermott, Larry Nauta and Lucia Robinson received 71, 118 and 90 votes respectively and no candidate received the necessary 40 percent. Since Mr. Nauta failed to file a Declaration of Candidacy with the Alaska Public Offices Commission he is disqualified and McDermott and Robinson will be candidates in a Runoff election for Seat G, a three year term on the Board of Directors.

38. That within the South Peninsula Hospital Service Area Elizabeth Fritz received 802 votes and is elected to Seat H, a three year term on the Board of Directors.

39. That within the South Peninsula Hospital Service Area T. H. Keffer received 984 votes and is elected to Seat I a three year term on the Board of Directors.

40. That Proposition 1 received 4,477 "Yes" votes and 3,075 "No" votes and is thereby approved by the voters of the Borough.

41. That Proposition 2 received 1,923 "Yes" votes and 2,465 "No" votes and is thereby defeated by the voters of the Borough.

42. That Proposition 3 received 3,635 "Yes" votes and 4,085 "No" votes and is thereby defeated by the voters of the Borough.
