PROPOSITION A:

"Shall each of the following school projects proposed by Ord. 82-51 be approved to authorize the Kenai Peninsula Borough to incur indebtedness and issue general obligation bonds in the amounts set out for each school for a total amount not to exceed \$53,540,000 which shall be utilized for the purpose of constructing, improving and equipping:

Tustumena School Addition in the amount of \$1,305,000?

Sterling School Addition in the amount of \$2,880,000?

YES 5,563 NO 1,737

New elementary school at Kalifornsky Beach in the amount of \$7,420,000?

YES 5,178 NO 2,118

Kenai Central High School 1,000 seat auditorium, and two special education classroom additions in the amount of \$10,650,000?

YES 4,435 NO 2,871

New high school at Homer, Alaska for the estimated cost of \$30,710,000?

YES 4,781 NO 2,612

Seldovia High School Addition for the estimated cost of \$575,000?

YES 5,539 NO 1,787

with payment of such indebtedness to be made from taxes levied within the Kenai Peninsula Borough, and from such other revenues as may be properly pledged for such payment, with full faith and credit of the Kenai Peninsula Borough pledged for the repayment of the indebtedness?"

NOW THEREFORE, THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
DECLARES:

1. That in District 1 Raymond Gillespie received 560 votes and is elected to a three year term in Seat B.
2. That in District 2 Kenn R. Stephens received 1,439 votes and is elected to a three year term in Seat B and David R. Carey received 1,330 votes and is elected to a one year term in Seat C.
3. That in District 3 Betty Glick received 1,048 votes and is elected to a three year term in Seat E.
4. That in District 4 Brentley D. Keene received 1,249 votes and is elected to a three year term in Seat B and Marilyn Dimmick received 1,201 votes and is elected to a 3 year term in Seat C.
5. That for Borough School Board Keith Wise received 2,816 votes and is elected to a one year term. Candidate Wayne Kessler received 3,870 votes and Mildred Martin received 2,583 votes and each is elected to a three year term.
6. That within the Bear Creek Fire Service Area George Zimmerman received 111 votes and is elected to a one year term in Seat B and Kerry Martin received 102 votes and is elected to a three year term in Seat C. There was no candidate for Seat D, therefore that vacancy will be filled by appointment until the next election.
7. That within the Central Peninsula Emergency Medical Service and Ambulance Service Area Robert Fenimore received 1,718 votes for Seat E and is elected to a three year term. There was no candidate for Seat A, therefore that vacancy will be filled by appointment until the next election.
8. That within the Central Kenai Peninsula Road Maintenance Service Area John G. Overway received 1,243 votes and is elected to a one year term in Seat D and Edward J. Costa received 1,219 votes and is elected to a three year term in Seat E.
9. That within the East Kenai Peninsula Road Maintenance Service Area declared write-in candidate Ronald Quilliam received 41 votes for Seat A but not 40% of the total write-in votes cast for that seat. There will be a runoff election between Quilliam and the next highest, Jim Skogstad, with 10 write-in votes for Seat A. There were no candidates for Seat B, C or D, therefore those vacancies will be filled by appointment until the next election. For Seat E Duane W. Ohnemus received 183 votes and is elected to a three year term.

10. That within the Nikiski Fire Service Area Billy A. McCann received 714 votes and is elected to a one year term, Seat A and Jimmie C. Conklin received 650 votes and is elected to a three year term in Seat D. Scott B. Hagen received 449 votes and is elected to a three year term in Seat E.

11. That within the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area Jim Goff received 607 votes and is elected to a three year term in Seat C. There were three candidates for Seat D, none of which received the required 40% and there will be a runoff election between Steve Epperheimer with 268 votes and John H. Nielsen with 263 votes; the candidate receiving the most votes will be elected.

12. That within the North Kenai Peninsula Road Maintenance Service Area Jo F. Cason received 367 votes and is elected to a three year term in Seat E.

13. That within the Ridgeway Fire Service Area Verlin Hoffman received 294 votes and is elected to a one year term in Seat B, Alexander Kime received 304 votes and is elected to a three year term in Seat C and John Lounsbury received 310 votes and is elected to a three year term in Seat D.

14. That within the South Kenai Peninsula Hospital Service Area Gene R. Williams received 1,443 votes and is elected to a three year term in Seat A, Marguerite Lambert received 1,402 votes and is elected to a three year term in Seat B and John P. Cooper received 1,537 votes and is elected for a three year term in Seat C.

15. That within the South Kenai Peninsula Road Maintenance Service Area Dwight Glanville received 791 votes and is elected to a two year term in Seat A, Marilyn Dimmick received 899 votes and is elected to a two year term in Seat B, and John Glanville received 786 votes and is elected to a one year term in Seat D. There was no candidate for Seat E, therefore that vacancy will be filled by appointment until the next election.

16. That Proposition A for approval of a bond issue not to exceed \$53,540,000 for construction of the following schools was approved by the voters of the Kenai Peninsula Borough: Tustumena School Addition, Sterling School Addition, a new elementary school at Kalifornsky Beach, a 1,000 seat auditorium for KCHS, a new high school for Homer, and Seldovia High School Addition.
