TOTAL NUMBER OF PERSONS VOTING IN THIS ELECTION: 6,051 (37%)

NOW THEREFORE, THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
DECLARES:

1. That in District 1, Seat A, David R. Cich received 529 votes and is elected to a three year term and in Seat B, Jonathan Sewall received 441 votes and is elected to a three year term.
2. That in District 2, Seat C, David R. Carey received 980 votes and is elected to a three year term. Since no candidate received the necessary 40% for Seat D, there will be a Runoff Election between candidates John Lounsbury and Paul Dale on October 25, 1983.
3. That in District 3, Seat A, Karen S. McGahan received 1071 votes and is elected to a three year term and in Seat D, Phil N. Nash received 843 votes and is elected to a three year term.
4. That in District 4, Seat D, Marie E. Walli received 802 votes and is elected to a three year term.
5. That for Borough School Board, Jane H. Hammond received 3046 votes and Joe E. Harris, Jr. received 1709 votes and are both elected to three year terms.
6. That within the Bear Creek Fire Service Area, Seat A, Edward Zimmerman received 62 votes and is elected to a three year term; in Seat B, George Zimmerman received 72 votes and is elected to a three year term and in Seat D, Clara M. Fultz received 68 votes and is elected to a two year term.
7. That within the East Kenai Peninsula Road Maintenance Service Area, Seat B, there was no candidate and no write-in received more than one vote; therefore the existing board will appoint a member to serve until the next regular election. In Seat C, Oscar Bailey received 187 votes and is elected to a three year term and in Seat D, James Skogstad received 196 votes and is elected to a three year term.
8. That within the Central Peninsula Emergency Medical Service and Ambulance Service Area, Seat A, Kenneth Hepner received 1096 votes and is elected to a one year term; in Seat C, James e. Matti received 1105 votes and is elected to a three year term and in Seat D, Darlene M. Wilder received 1177 votes and is elected to a three year term.
9. That within the Central Kenai Peninsula Road Maintenance Service Area, Seat C, Kathryn L. Mattison received 835 votes and is elected to a three year term and in Seat D, there was no candidate but David Waite received 16 write-in votes and is elected, if found willing to serve, to a three year term.

10. That within the Ridgeway Fire Service Area, Seat A, Glenn D. Schrader received 215 votes and is elected to a three year term; in Seat B, Verlin D. Hoffman received 200 votes and is elected to a three year term and in Seat E there was no candidate but R. L. Parker received two write-in votes and is elected, if found willing to serve, to a one year term.

11. That within the Nikiski Fire Service Area, Seat A, Billy A. McCann received 487 votes and is elected to a three year term; in Seat B, Preston L. Williams received 418 votes and is elected to a three year term and in Seat C, John Yanak received 408 votes and is elected to a three year term.

12. That within the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area, Seat A, Ty Miller received 475 votes and is elected to a three year term and in Seat B, Jean Gregory received 357 votes and is elected to a three year term.

13. That within the North Kenai Peninsula Road Maintenance Service Area, Seat C, C. Linsey Clark received 274 votes and is elected to a three year term. In seat D, candidates Arthur C. Stites and Marti McGahan each received 270 votes and following a recount of ballots the tally remains the same, therefore the seat will be decided upon by lot.

14. That within the South Peninsula Hospital Service Area, Seat G, Michael L. Daugherty received 1002 votes and is elected to a three year term; in Seat H, Elizabeth Fritz received 966 votes and is elected to a three year term and Tom Keffer received 899 votes and is elected to a three year term.

15. That within the South Kenai Peninsula Road Maintenance Service Area, Seat C, Susan L. Ingels received 695 votes and is elected to a three year term. In Seat D there was no candidate and among write-ins, two names, Herb Middleton and Gene McBride, each received two votes; final decision resting with the board. In Seat E there were no candidates but Harry Olson received two write-in votes and is elected, if found willing to serve, to a two year term.

16. That Proposition 7 for the establishment of the Anchor Point Fire and Emergency Service Area was approved by a vote of 115 yes to 70 no and the Board of Directors was elected as follows: In Seat A, Joe L. Aprill received 79 votes and is elected to a three year term; in Seat B, Terry Thoms received 88 votes and is elected to a three year term; in Seat C there was no candidate but Richard Ragland received 12 write-in votes and is elected to a two year term; in Seat D, Rebecca J. Symens received 129 votes and is elected to a two year term and in Seat E there was no candidate but Earnest Salathe received 8 write-in votes and is elected, if found willing to serve to a one year term.

17. That Proposition 1 approving transfer of bond funds from the Homer High School project to approved school construction projects was approved by the voters by a vote of 3003 Yes to 2393 No.

18. That Proposition 2 approving the sale of bonds for the Soldotna Jr. High School Addition in the amount of \$6,845,000 was approved by a vote of 3349 Yes to 2233 No.


19. That Proposition 3 approving the sale of bonds for the Paul Banks Elementary Addition in the amount of \$1,440,000 was approved by a vote of 3534 Yes to 2053 No.

20. That Proposition 4 approving the sale of bonds for the English Bay School Addition in the amount of \$2,095,000 was approved by a vote of 3367 Yes to 1988 No.

21. That Proposition 5 approving the sale of bonds for the Port Graham School Addition in the amount of \$1,495,000 was approved by a vote of 3392 Yes to 1948 No.


22. That Proposition 6 approving the sale of bonds for the Homer High School Additive Alternates in the amount of \$4,790,000 was approved by a vote of 2837 Yes to 2525 No.
