RESOLUTION 83-22

CERTIFYING THE RESULTS OF THE ANCHOR POINT FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICE AREA ELECTION OF JANUARY 11, 1983

WHEREAS, the assembly has received from the Canvassing Board the "Certification of Special Election" of the election held on January 11, 1983; and

WHEREAS, the Certification records the Proposition before the voters of the Anchor Point Precinct read as follows:

"Do you approve establishment of the Anchor Point Fire and Emergency Service Area as described on the ballot, in Ordinance 82-77, and in Resolution 82-219, for the purpose of providing fire protection services to the residents of the Anchor Point Fire and Emergency Service Area with a mill rate not to exceed 2 mills?"; and

WHEREAS, the total number of persons voting in this election was 303, including questioned and absentee voters;


NOW THEREFORE, THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH DECLARES:

That with 135 persons voting Yes and 166 persons voting No the Proposition failed approval by the voters of the portion of the Anchor Point Precinct described in Ordinance 82-77.
