NOW THEREFORE, THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH DECLARES:

- 1. That no candidate for Borough Mayor received the required 50% vote and a Runoff Election will be held with Sharon Jean and Stan Thompson the only candidates for that office.
- 2. That four candidates for three Board of Education seats received the required 40% and those receiving the highest votes, Jerry Hobart, Debra Mullins and Darlene Wilder, are elected to three year terms.
- 3. That in District 1, Seat A, James Skogstad was elected by more than 40% to a 3 year term on the Assembly.
- 4. That in District 2, Seats A and E, no candidate received 40% and a Runoff Election will be held between Tommy Corr and Fran Moore for Seat A and there will be a Runoff Election between Ty Handley and Frank Mullen for Seat E, both three year terms.
- 5. That in District 3, Seat B, Ron Johnson was elected to a three year term and Gary Fandel was elected to Seat C, a three year term as an unopposed candidate.
- 6. That in District 4, John Crawford was elected to Seat A, a three year term as an unopposed candidate.
- 7. That in the Bear Creek Fire Service Area, Max Young received 20 votes as a write-in candidate and will be offered the opportunity to serve in Seat E, a three year term.
- 8. That in the East Kenai Peninsula Road Maintenance Service Area there were no candidates for three vacancies, but persons receiving the most write-in votes are as follows: Seat A, Ron Quilliam, three year term, Seat B, Paul Pacquette, three year term, and Seat E, Ken Baysinger, one year term.
- 9. That in the Central Peninsula Emergency Medical Service Area, Kenneth Hepner was elected to Seat A, three year term and David Christian Morgan was elected to Seat B, a three year term.
- 10. That in the Central Kenai Peninsula Road Maintenance Service Area, Len Bunts was elected to Seat A, a three year term. There was no candidate for Seat B and the seat will be offered to Bob Pope, who received the most write-in votes for the three year term.
- ll. That in Ridgeway Fire Service Area, Seat E, David L. Wynkoop was elected to a three year term, unopposed.

- 12. That in Nikiski Fire Service Area, Seat F, Gene Browning was elected to a three year term and Terry D. King was elected to Seat G, a three year term.
- 13. That in the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area Ron Johnson was elected to Seat E, a three year term.
- 14. That in the North Kenai Peninsula Road Maintenance Service Area, Alan J. Bute was elected to Seat A, a three year term and Judith A. Dixon was elected to Seat B, a three year term.
- 15. That in the South Peninsula Hospital Service Area Howard Myhill was elected to Seat D, a three year term, Leroy Gannaway was elected to Seat E, a three year term and Viola Hansen was elected to Seat F, a three year term.
- 16. That in the South Kenai Peninsula Road Maintenance Service Area Marilyn Dimmick was elected to Seat B, a three year term. As there was no candidate for Seat A and Seat E, the person receiving the most write-in votes for the respective seats will be offered the opportunity to serve, Marsha Grove in Seat A and Drew Scalzi in Seat E.
- 17. That in the Anchor Point Fire and Emergency Service Area, Seat E, Henrietta Ledger was elected to a three year term.
- 18. That Proposition No. 1 for an incinerator facility was defeated by the voters of the entire Borough.
- 19. That Proposition No. 2 for non-areawide ports and harbors power was defeated by the voters of the area outside cities, Boroughwide.
- 20. That Proposition No. 3 for an addition to Central Peninsula Hospital was approved by the voters of the Central Peninsula Hospital Service Area.
