RESOLUTION 86-115

CERTIFYING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL BOROUGH ELECTION HELD ON JULY 29, 1986

WHEREAS, the canvassing board of the Kenai Peninsula Borough met on August 4, 1986 and tallied the votes of Questioned and Absentee ballots together with votes counted on election night as shown below:

PROPOSITION A: "Should the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances, Section 10.18.020 and 10.18.050, which currently provide for a year-round ban on the sale and use of fireworks be amended to provide for a partial ban on sale and use of fireworks whereby the sale and use would be prohibited only from April 1 through June 17, and from July 8 through October 1, of each calendar year (permit- ting sale and use of fireworks June 18th through July 7th, and October 2nd through March 31st) outside cities?"

NOW THEREFORE, THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH DECLARES:


Section 1. That in the Borough wide election in response to initiative petition, Proposition A was defeated both inside and outside cities.

Section 2. That in the Bear Creek Fire Service Area the expansion of powers to include emergency medical services was approved by the voters of that service area.
