Section 1. That in the Boroughwide election for two Board of Education Members, Betty Obendorf and Mildred "Milli" Martin received in excess of the required 40% and are elected to three year terms.

Section 2. That in Assembly District 1, Seat B, Jonathan W. Sewall was reelected to a three year term of office.

Section 3. That in Assembly District 2, David R. Carey was reelected to Seat C, a three year term, and Patrick M. O'Connell was elected to Seat D, a three year term of office.

Section 4. That in Assembly District 3, Karen S. McGahan was reelected to Seat A, a three year term, and Phil N. Nash was reelected to Seat D, a three year term of office.

Section 5. That in Assembly District 4, Marie E. Walli was reelected to Seat D, a three year term of office.

Section 6. That in the Anchor Point Fire and Ambulance Service Area, Joe L. Aprill was reelected to Seat A, a three year term, Lawrence J. DeBroeck was elected to Seat B, a three year term, and Mary Shannon was elected to Seat E, a 1 year term through write-in votes as there was no candidate for this office.

- Section 15. That in the Ridgeway/Sterling Fire Service Area, David L. Wynkoop was elected to Seat A, a three year term and Randal A. Nicklas was elected to Seat B, a three year term.
- Section 16. That in the South Kenai Peninsula Road Maintenance Service Area, Dwight Glanville was elected to Seat A, a one year term, Bernhard Von Keitz was elected to Seat C, a three year term, and Ara E. Roth, Jr. was elected to Seat D, a three year term of office.

Section 17. That in the South Kenai Peninsula Hospital Service Area, Michael L. Daugherty was reelected to Seat G, a three year term, Elizabeth B. Fritz was reelected to Seat H, a three year term, and Thomas H. Keffer was reelected to Seat I, a three year term of office.

Section 18. That Proposition No. 1, authorizing the sale of general obligation bonds for a new Seward elementary school was defeated by the voters Boroughwide.

Section 19. That Proposition No. 2, granting an exemption from taxation on the assessed value of real property exceeding the exemption granted by state statutes was approved by the voters Boroughwide.

 $\underline{\text{Section 20}}.$ That Proposition No. 3, proposed through an initiative petition would have set a salary and benefit cap of \$50,000 effective July 1, 1987, for all borough employees was defeated by the voters Boroughwide.

Section 21. That Proposition No. 4 for the recall of Assembly Member Thomas F. Brown from District 4, Seat C, was approved by the voters of District 4 and that seat will be vacant upon certification of this election.
