KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 89-88

PLACING A PROPOSITION BEFORE THE VOTERS TO RATIFY ORDINANCE 89-5, WHICH REMOVED RESTRICTIONS ON HIRING AND EXPENDITURES FROM THE NON-AREAWIDE PORT AND HARBOR POWERS OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 89-5 amended the ordinance and voter approval governing non-areawide port and harbor powers by removing limitations on expenditures and hiring or use of employees; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of removing those limitations is to allow the Borough to reasonably administer those powers; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 89-5 must be ratified by the voters in the area outside cities to remove the limitations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the following proposition be placed before the voters in areas outside of cities at the October 3, 1989, municipal election:

PROPOSITION 2: REMOVING LIMITATIONS ON THE NON-AREAWIDE PORT AND HARBOR POWERS OF THE BOROUGH REGARDING EMPLOYMENT AND EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS. DO YOU RATIFY ORDINANCE 89-5 ADOPTED BY THE ASSEMBLY TO REMOVE RESTRICTIONS ON HIRING OR USE OF EMPLOYEES IN CARRYING OUT THE BOROUGH'S NON-AREAWIDE PORT AND HARBOR POWERS, AND WHICH ALSO REMOVES RESTRICTIONS THAT ANY CAPITAL EXPENDITURES FOR THOSE PURPOSES BE APPROVED BY THE VOTERS? REMOVAL OF THESE RESTRICTIONS WOULD NOT ELIMINATE THE BOROUGH CODE REQUIREMENT OF VOTER APPROVAL FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS OF \$1,000,000 OR MORE WHERE TAX FUNDS ARE USED.


