## RESOLUTION 89-88

PLACING A PROPOSITION BEFORE THE VOTERS TO RATIFY ORDINANCE 89-5, WHICH REMOVED RESTRICTIONS ON HIRING AND EXPENDITURES FROM THE NON-AREAWIDE PORT AND HARBOR POWERS OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 89-5 amended the ordinance and voter approval governing non-areawide port and harbor powers by removing limitations on expenditures and hiring or use employees; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of removing those limitations is to allow the Borough to reasonably administer those powers; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 89-5 must be ratified by the voters in the area outside cities to remove the limitations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the following proposition be placed before the voters in areas outside of cities at the October 3, 1989, municipal election:

PROPOSITION 2: REMOVING LIMITATIONS ON THE NON-AREAWIDE PORT AND HARBOR POWERS OF THE BOROUGH REGARDING EMPLOYMENT AND EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS. DO YOU RATIFY ORDINANCE 89-5 ADOPTED BY THE ASSEMBLY TO REMOVE RESTRICTIONS ON HIRING OR USE OF EMPLOYEES IN CARRYING OUT THE BOROUGH'S NON-AREAWIDE PORT AND HARBOR POWERS, AND WHICH ALSO REMOVES RESTRICTIONS THAT ANY CAPITAL EXPENDITURES FOR THOSE PURPOSES BE APPROVED BY THE VOTERS?
