**A RESOLUTION CLASSIFYING BOROUGH LANDS LOCATED
WITHIN A PORTION OF SECTION 36, TOWNSHIP 8 NORTH, RANGE 12 WEST,
SEWARD MERIDIAN, ALASKA FOR SCHOOL PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, the borough has received state patent to certain lands located within Section 36, T8N, R12W, S.M., pursuant to the Municipal Entitlement Act; and,

WHEREAS, a request to classify certain lands for a future school site within Section 36, T8N, R12W, S.M., has been received from the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District; and

WHEREAS, review and comments were requested from borough departments, school district, service areas and any other interested parties in accordance with standard procedures; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission, on July 1, 1991, recommended approval of the classification;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the following described lands are hereby classified as "Retained Lands" for a school site:

Portion of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and portion S $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ lying northerly of Education Drive, easterly of Nikishka Beach Road and westerly of Nikiski High School Subdivision, all within Sec. 36, T8N, R12W, S.M.


Section 2. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly recommends that public hearings should be conducted by the school board on all future school site selections.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
