**A RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING \$14,000 FOR SCHEMATIC DESIGN AND
COST ESTIMATION SERVICES TO CONVERT THE HOMER JR. HIGH POOL
TO A MULTIPURPOSE ROOM AND CAFETERIA**

WHEREAS, the Homer Jr. High School Parent Advisory Committee has requested that the pool at the facility be converted into a multipurpose room and cafeteria

WHEREAS, earlier consideration of this idea resulted in a complex design that would be expensive to construct; and

WHEREAS, use of that design would not be feasible due to the cost, especially considering today's economic circumstances; and

WHEREAS, the same architect could revise the scope of the existing design to reflect a 'bare bones' project which would remodel the pool area into a usable multipurpose room/cafeateria; and


WHEREAS, funds remaining from the appropriation to purchase land for the Homer Elementary II project are available for transfer to this project for schematic design and cost estimating;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That \$14,000 is transferred from the Homer Elementary II account 400.720500,49999.86246 to account 400.720300,49999.POOL1.
