KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH RESOLUTION 92-01

AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY USE OF LANDS LOCATED WITHIN SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 14 WEST SEWARD MERIDIAN, ALASKA TO PENINSULA SLED DOG RACING ASSOCIATION

- WHEREAS, an application has been received from Mary S. Olson, Board of Directors member of the Peninsula Sled Dog Racing Association, for the temporary use of borough lands; and
- WHEREAS, said temporary use of the land is for holding a "Businessman's Race" with monies received being divided evenly between a charity and the Peninsula Sled Dog Racing Association; and
- WHEREAS, the borough selected the subject land pursuant to the Municipal Entitlement Act and has received patent from the State of Alaska; and
- WHEREAS, on November 6, 1991, a memorandum, maps and supporting backup was sent out for review and comments to the School District, South Peninsula Hospital Service Area, and departments of the borough; and
- WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Planning Commission considered this temporary use of lands at their regular meeting of December 16, 1991 and recommended the assembly grant the temporary use of lands as requested;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- That a one time use permit is hereby authorized for the Peninsula Sled Dog Racing Association for a portion of the E½NW¼ of Section 15, T6S, R14W, S.M., lying northerly of the Sterling Highway. No fee shall be charged for this permit.
- Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to sign any documents necessary to effectuate this resolution and deemed to be in the best interest of the borough.
