**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 92-15**

A RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING \$12,000 FOR ASSEMBLY LEGISLATIVE TRAVEL

WHEREAS, the Assembly did not authorize a legislative liaison position for the 1992 state legislative session; and

WHEREAS, in the absence of a legislative liaison, it will be necessary for increased assembly travel to Juneau to perform lobbying functions and to monitor legislation and activities of the state legislature; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds were not budgeted for assembly travel for these purposes;

WHEREAS, funds were budgeted under Contract Services for lobbying purposes in the Mayor's Administrative budget; and

WHEREAS, without a legislative liaison position, these funds are not needed in the Mayor's account and may be transferred;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That \$12,000 be transferred from 100.112010.43011, Mayor Administration, Contract Services, to 100.111010.43216, Assembly Administration, Travel In State.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
