A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A LEGISLATIVE LIAISON POSITION

WHEREAS, it is desirable to have an individual in place in Juneau to perform lobbying functions and to coordinate the Borough's activities during each annual state legislative session; and

WHEREAS, additional appropriations are not necessary to cover the cost of the liaison position for 1992 which is projected to be approximately \$32,000 including benefits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the position of legislative liaison with a maximum annualized salary of \$48,645 is established.

Section 2. That this position will exist for six months each year to coincide with state legislative sessions.


Section 3. That the attached job description is approved and incorporated by reference.
