- WHEREAS, due to this extremely heavy caseload, an additional prosecutor is strongly needed to ease the pressure now placed on the current prosecutors; and,
- WHEREAS, the employment of an additional prosecutor would enable the Alaska court system to better serve the citizens of the State of Alaska;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ADOPTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- Section 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly supports the employment of an additional prosecutor in the District Attorney's office at the Kenai Courthouse to ease the pressure and better serve the citizens of the State of Alaska.
- Section 2. That copies of this resolution be sent to Governor Walter J. Hickel, Attorney General Charles E. Cole, Assistant Attorney General Dean Guaneli, Representative Gail Phillips, Representative Mike Navarre, and Senator Paul A. Fischer.
