- WHEREAS, improved communication between citizens of all areas of the Kenai Peninsula Borough and the Legislature would be mutually beneficial;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- Section 1. That the Assembly urges the Alaska State Legislature to authorize and provide funding for the establishment and operation of a Legislative Information Office in Seward.
- Section 2. That copies of this resolution shall be distributed to Senators Paul Fischer, Jay Kerttula and Curt Menard and Representatives Gene Kubina, Mike Navarre, Gail Phillips and Jim Zawacki.
- Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
