- WHEREAS, the requested five foot easement would lie along the southern boundary of Kenai Pipeline Company's 50 foot pipeline easement and will keep the phone pedestals out of the now traveled easement; and

That an utility easement for an underground phone line described as being five foot in width and running approximately 1320 feet lying along the southern boundary of Kenai Pipeline Company's 50 foot pipeline easement (A-052005) all within the W¹/₂SW¹/₄ Section 1, T7N, R11W, S.M., Alaska.
- Section 2. That PTI Communications will provide a final as-built survey within one year upon completion of the project.
- Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to sign such documents necessary to effectuate this easement.
- Section 4. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
