RESOLUTION 92-33**

**A RESOLUTION GRANTING PTI COMMUNICATIONS
A UTILITY EASEMENT ACROSS BOROUGH OWNED LANDS**

WHEREAS, PTI Communications has requested an easement for a buried cable placement on Borough property; and

WHEREAS, this request is on borough owned lands patented on September 17, 1982; and

WHEREAS, the requested five foot easement would lie along the southern boundary of Kenai Pipeline Company's 50 foot pipeline easement and will keep the phone pedestals out of the now traveled easement; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Planning Commission considered this request at their meeting of March 9, 1992 and recommended approval;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That an utility easement for an underground phone line described as being five foot in width and running approximately 1320 feet lying along the southern boundary of Kenai Pipeline Company's 50 foot pipeline easement (A-052005) all within the W $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 1, T7N, R11W, S.M., Alaska.

Section 2. That PTI Communications will provide a final as-built survey within one year upon completion of the project.

Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to sign such documents necessary to effectuate this easement.


Section 4. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
