BOROUGH MAYOR, ASSEMBLY AND SCHOOL BOARD ON THE  
OCTOBER 1992 BALLOT AS AN ADVISORY VOTE**

**WHEREAS**, currently the mayor and members of the assembly and school board can serve for an indefinite number of terms; and

**WHEREAS**, an advisory vote will indicate whether the public is concerned with limiting the term of the mayor, assembly and school board members to two consecutive full terms of office;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

**Section 1.** That the following question shall be placed before the voters at the regular election of October 6, 1992 as an advisory vote:


Advisory Proposition: Shall the term of offices of the borough mayor, assemblymembers and school board members be limited to two consecutive full terms?
