**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING LEGISLATION ESTABLISHING  
A LOCAL GOVERNMENT POSTAL RATE**

**WHEREAS,** the National Association of Counties has urged Congress to hold hearings on the impact of recent and potential postal rate increases on local governments; and

**WHEREAS,** such hearings were held in November 1991, and the recommendations of the National Association of Counties and local governments throughout the United States are now before the U.S. House of Representatives Subcommittee on Postal Operations and Services of the Committee on Post Office and Civil Service; and


**WHEREAS,** it is now imperative that local governments throughout the United States show their support for the implementation of such Legislation;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:**


**Section 1.** That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly does hereby urge the Congress of the United States to support legislation to establish a local government postal rate or the utilization of the "not-for-profit" rate for local governments for the distribution of mandated services at the local level such as jury service notices, voter registration receipts, tax notification, utility bills, etc. in an effort to benefit the taxpayers of the United States at the local level.

**Section 2.** That copies of this resolution be sent to Senators Ted Stevens and Frank Murkowski and Representative Don Young and Representative Frank McCloskey, Chair of the Subcommittee on Postal Operations and Services.
