KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 92-70

**PROVIDING FOR A BALLOT PROPOSITION TO AUTHORIZE  
THE LEVY OF TAXES TO A MAXIMUM OF 0.5 MILLS FOR BOTH  
ROAD MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN  
THE KENAI PENINSULA ROAD SERVICE AREA**

**WHEREAS**, current levels of state funding for road maintenance within the Kenai Peninsula Service Area are inadequate to properly maintain road conditions; and

**WHEREAS**, state funding will continually be reduced due to declining revenues; and

**WHEREAS**, local funds will be required to maintain the current level of service; and

**WHEREAS**, accelerating growth within the Kenai Peninsula Road Service Area has placed increased traffic pressure on roads; and

**WHEREAS**, in many areas there is a definite need for continued maintenance of the roads to accommodate the increasing growth and to prevent further road deterioration; and

**WHEREAS**, on May 11, 1992 the Kenai Peninsula Road Service Area Board unanimously passed a resolution calling for a tax of 1/2 mill for road maintenance to be placed before the voters.

**WHEREAS**, the Assembly deems it appropriate to establish a total levy of .5 mills for both maintenance and improvements rather than having a separate levy authority of .5 mills for each;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

**Section 1.** That the following proposition shall be placed before the voters of the Kenai Peninsula Road Service Area at the next regular election on October 6, 1992.

PROPOSITION: Shall the Kenai Peninsula Borough be empowered to provide for both maintenance and improvements from the levy of a tax not to exceed 0.5 mills within the Kenai Peninsula Road Service Area that was previously authorized for improvements only?


