**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO NEGOTIATIONS
TO PURCHASE PROPERTY ADJACENT TO LANDS RECENTLY ACQUIRED FOR
SOLDOTNA LANDFILL BUFFER**

WHEREAS, Richard B. & Lynn N. Herrick have ownership of property legally described as T4N-R11W, Sec.13, R. M. Kananen Homestead, Tract 1, Assessor's Parcel #R-131-094-27; and

WHEREAS, this property was included in the original Kenai Peninsula Borough Ordinance 91-3, authorizing the Mayor to negotiate to acquire for landfill buffer property; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough offered to purchase said property from the Herrick's on February 19, 1991 and the offer was subsequently rejected on March 18, 1991; and


WHEREAS, Mr. Herrick has reconsidered his position and requests reopening negotiations for purchase of his property by the Kenai Peninsula Borough;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


SECTION 1. That the Mayor may negotiate with Richard B. & Lynn N. Herrick to acquire their property.
