- WHEREAS, provisions needs to be established in the event of a runoff in these districts; and

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ADOPTED B THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- SECTION 1. That, in the event of a runoff election for \$1,5 ft, Jim Skogstad will remain on the Assembly until a successor is sworn in and kes office.
- SECTION 2. That, in the event of a runoff election for Seat 9 auzz Kyllonen will remain on the Assembly until a successor is sworn in and take office.
- **SECTION 3.** That, in the event of a runoff election for Seat 2, the Number candidate who does not get elected to Seat 3 will remain on the Assemble until a successor is sworn in and takes office.
