RESOLUTION 92-107

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING INTERIM ASSEMBLY RULES

WHEREAS, at the October 1, 1991, Regular Borough Election, the voters of the Kenai Peninsula Borough elected a reapportionment plan which called for nine single member assembly districts; and

WHEREAS, this new assembly apportionment takes effect with the certification of the 1992 Regular Borough Election; and

WHEREAS, upon certification the composition of the assembly will be reduced from sixteen members to nine members; and

WHEREAS, there is the possibility of a runoff in three of the new assembly districts where there are more than two candidates; and

WHEREAS, provisions needs to be established in the event of a runoff in these districts; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ADOPTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That, in the event of a runoff election for Seat 6, Jim Skogstad will remain on the Assembly until a successor is sworn in and takes office.

SECTION 2. That, in the event of a runoff election for Seat 9, Buzz Kyllonen will remain on the Assembly until a successor is sworn in and takes office.

SECTION 3. That, in the event of a runoff election for Seat 2, the incumbent candidate who does not get elected to Seat 3 will remain on the Assembly until a successor is sworn in and takes office.
