**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE  
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES TO INCREASE  
THE SPEED LIMIT TO 45 MILES PER HOUR IN THE STERLING AREA**

**WHEREAS**, a request has been submitted to the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to increase the speed limit to 45 miles per hour in the Sterling area; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities has taken a speed study which is one component needed to determine a speed limit and it was determined that 85% of the traffic moving through Sterling is traveling at or less than 45 miles per hour the Department has recommended the speed limit be increased to 45 miles per hour; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been documented that a reasonable speed limit that the majority of motorists travel is the safest speed; and


**WHEREAS**, the Department of Public Safety has seen no major increases in traffic accidents throughout the construction area of the Sterling Highway and feel that 45 miles per hour is a reasonable speed through the Sterling area;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ADOPTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:**


**SECTION 1.** That copies of this resolution be sent to the Department of Transportation and Public Safety.
