KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH **RESOLUTION 92-122**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH TO ACT AS LOCAL SPONSOR FOR A FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR A SMALL BOAT HARBOR AT ANCHOR POINT

- WHEREAS, Army Corps of Engineers has completed a final draft reconnaissance report for a small boat harbor project near the mouth of the Anchor River; and
- WHEREAS, report indicates a small boat harbor may have merit as a COE project but a feasibility study would have to be conducted to determine if the project should receive further consideration by the COE; and
- WHEREAS, the COE indicates that funding is available for the feasibility study phase for this project; and
- WHEREAS, the feasibility study phase requires a local sponsor to provide 50% matching funds for a project of this type; and
- WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has funding available for the necessary match that can be made available through a transfer of responsibilities agreement with the borough to act as the local sponsor for the feasibility study phase;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the borough may act as the local sponsor for a feasibility study phase for a small boat harbor project at Anchor Point to be conducted by the Corps of Engineers on a 50/50 cost sharing basis with a maximum borough participation of \$250,000. Participation as a local sponsor is subject to execution of a transfer of responsibilities agreement with the State of Alaska to provide the funds for the borough participation. Borough participation is expressly limited to amount received from the State for this study and no other borough funds shall be used for this study.
- **SECTION 2.** That participation as a local sponsor during the feasibility study phase of this project shall not be construed as obligating the borough to participate in any further phases should the project be determined feasible as a result of the feasibility study.

- **SECTION 3.** The mayor may execute such agreements for participation in the feasibility study for transfer of the funds from the state as may be necessary for the borough to participate subject to the provisions of this resolution.
- **SECTION 4.** That the borough will appropriate as necessary any funds received from the state for participation in the study.

SECTION 5. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
